

# **VIOLATIONS – ESCALATION LEVEL**

If a driver, mechanic or guest disregards the rules of conduct, this will be sanctioned by the organizer in the following stages:

I. Level: Warning


II. Level: Ban from event area for 2 hours

III. Level: Ban from event area for 1 day

IV. Level: Disqualification

The rider is responsible for the behavior of his companions!

### **Night Parking Area:**

## **WELCOME CENTER**

The Welcome Center is located in front of the entrance to the event area. Here, every person who has been **previously registered by name** receives their access authorization.

The access authorization (wristband) is fastened directly to the wrist after the check of the identity card and handing in the Covid self-disclosure.

Each person must take their ticket themselves.

No receipt for third parties!

#### **Process**

- 1. Queue up
- 2. Every person must provide documents
  - a. ID card
  - b. Covid self-declaration
- 3. Drive up on request
- 4. Hand in Covid self-declaration
- Check of ID card
- 6. Fastening of wristband (access authorization)
- 7. Paddock instructions by staff

## **PADDOCK**

Walking speed must be maintained with all vehicles on the event area.

### **Opening hours**

Friday from 09:00 to 23:00

Saturday from 07:00 to ca. 22:00

Sunday from 07:00

### **Important**

Trailers must arrive by Friday 18:00 at the latest. Only cables for outdoor use according to IP44 standards may be used after prior testing and marking. Vehicle access is possible during these times only! The instructions of the paddock staff must be followed!

### **Fuel**

Refueling is only allowed in the tank boxes in the paddock or in your own vehicle/trailer. These are governmental regulations, which will be sanctioned by the organizer in case of violation.

No general mask obligation in paddock!

If minimum distance of 1.5 m cannot be kept, a mask must be worn correctly (e.g. working on motorcycle)!

# PADDOCK RULES OF CONDUCT

Gathering of people should always be avoided!

Contact between people from different households/teams should be kept to a minimum! Any unnecessary movement outside the own team area is to be avoided.

**Teams and riders are responsible for regular cleaning of the surfaces and good air circulation** in the tents/trucks/caravans etc. Sufficient disinfection materials must be kept in stock!

Regular hand washing and/or disinfection is mandatory!

Violations will be sanctioned by the organizer.

No general mask obligation in paddock!

If minimum distance of 1.5 m cannot be kept, a mask must be worn correctly (e.g. working on motorcycle)!

# DOCUMENT CHECK / TECHICAL SCRUTINEERING

#### **Document Check**

The document check is located at the end of the paddock in direction of the racetrack. Please remember to have a **valid and signed license** for the 2020 season. Foreign riders also need the **foreign starting permission** of the respective federation.


### **Technical Scrutineering**

The technical inspection is located between paddock 2 (Masters paddock) and paddock 3.

Please show the **ESC number of the helmet** visibly and then lay the helmet on the table. In American models the number is located in the helmet shell.

We kindly ask you to complete the inspections already on Friday.

Masks are mandatory in these areas. Please make sure that the mask is worn correctly and that the minimum distance of 1,5 m is kept.


### TRACK PLAN

### **Compulsory Mask**

Wherever the minimum distance of 1.5m cannot be maintained, a mask must be worn correctly!

Everyone is responsible for carrying a mask. The organizer does not provide masks!




# **PRESTART**

All riders access the pre-start via the appropriate access road (pink). **No motocross bikes** are tolerated **on the main route**.

### Absolute mask obligation in prestart!

Only riders and mechanics of the respective class have access to the prestart.



## **MECHANIC BOX**

#### **Absolute mask obligation in mechanic box!**

Access to the mechanic box is permitted with a mechanic wristband of the respective class. Every mechanic must name his rider when entering the helper box.

Guest bands have no access. Bicycles and animals are not allowed in the mechanic box. Smoking is absolutely forbidden.

Pay attention to the marking at the bottom of the mechanic box and keep the lane clear!

We ask all riders to renounce all jewelry (earrings, necklaces, etc.). Paramedics have pointed out that jewelry has led to injuries and e.g. earrings hinder removing helmets.




# **SPECTATOR AREA**

For all team members and accompanying persons who do not have access to the mechanic box, a monitor is available in the spectator area in the infield of the track to follow the times.

The times can also be followed via Live timing (see Timekeeping).

No general mask obligation in spectator area!

If minimum distance of 1.5 m cannot be kept, a mask must be worn correctly!

We kindly ask you to comply with the hygiene regulations to the best of your knowledge and belief! In that way we ensure a proper self-protection and guarantee the protection of others. Furthermore we give responsible images to the outside world.

All press representatives as well as the TV crew will pay attention to the compliance with the corona regulations of the organizer. Riders and attendees who violate the regulations are deliberately not shown on media level! Please also pay attention to the adherence to the hygiene regulations for private postings.

We kindly ask riders, team members and accompanying persons to wear a mask when the riders return from the races.

# WINNING INTERVIEW / AWARD CEREMONY

After each run, the winner will be asked for a short interview on the podium for the livestream. For publicity purposes we ask the riders to wear a mask in this situation.

The overall award ceremony takes place after the last run of the respective class. Absolute mask obligation during award ceremony!

The ADAC provides masks for the interview and the award ceremony.

We kindly ask riders, team members and accompanying persons to wear a mask when the riders return from the races. Riders should be handed their mask after helmet removal.


# **CLEANING-SITE**

Absolute mask obligation at cleaning-site!

Only the washing machines provided by the organizer may be used.

Washing outside the cleaning-site is prohibited!

There are 10 wash boxes at disposal. All persons are requested to complete the washing process as quick as possible.



# **TIMEKEEPING**



#### **Livetiming**

At every ADAC MX Masters event site (paddock and mechanic box), live timing is accessible via the timekeeping WLAN.

To do this, select the website www.timekeeping.local on your browser after dialing into the WLAN.

Via WLAN you can also view or download all result lists. There will be no printed lists at the race office or in the press area!

All results/lists will be available on the MX Masters website after the event!



### **Transponders**

Transponders can be borrowed for a fee of 20,-€ plus 10,-€ deposit per weekend during administrative checks.

After the races transponders are taken back at the race office. Licenses are returned and prize money if paid out at the race office as well.

# **PITBIKES**

Only teams with a team enrolment are allowed to use a pitbike (marked with a valid pitbike sticker) at the paddock.

For all others, pit biking is prohibited. The organizer and the ADAC will control compliance with the ban.

### PRIZE MONEY

#### **Prize Money**

The payout takes place on **Sunday from 16 o'clock** at the **race** office. Riders will also receive their licenses back.

### **Annual Prize Money**

The annual prize money will be paid to all riders by a bank transfer for the first time. At the end of September you will receive further information about the prize money payment as well as the reimbursement of the entry fee paid before Corona. Eligible for payment of the annual prize money are riders of all

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**



#### **Test Track**

The test track can be found between cleaning-site and medical tent.



Refueling is only allowed in the tank boxes in the paddock or in your own vehicle/trailer. These are governmental regulations, which will be sanctioned by the organizer in case of violation.

### Wasser

Water is available near the ADAC truck.

### **Pit Radio**

Pit radio between rider and pit is prohibited by the DMSB!



While working on the motorcycle an underlying pad is a requirement. Cleaning work on motorcycles is allowed in the designated cleaning-site only.
